

## **NMIS Board – Bitfocus/Clarity Proposal July 2019**

Approximate bill to CAN by NMIS/CCFL - \$628.72/license; \$62,243.62 **YEAR 1**

- Includes setup, configuration, data migration and first year licensing cost
- \$354,600 total

Approximate bill to CAN by NMIS/CCFL in **YEAR 2** - \$338.30/license; \$33,491.49

- \$190,800 total

NMIS Board – looking into paying for \$50,000+

- Seeking funding from the Nebraska Investment Finance Authority (NIFA)
- Potential state trust funding, larger foundations, etc. after NIFA
- Initial TA requests to HUD for assistance to Nebraska CoCs were denied
- Workgroup: continue fee/license model for payment of database
  - o Will meet (call) after Jeff Chambers (CCFL) hears back from NIFA

As a Network, we decide if the licenses we have are the licenses we NEED. The fewer the licenses, the lower the total cost.

ServicePoint licenses are up-to-date and renew in May of 2020. NMIS Board will be invoicing Board members before the end of September for new database costs, as Bitfocus needs payment soon after agreement.

Suggestion to CAAs: decide whether or not the amount of licenses you currently have at your Agency is adequate for your needs. Next NMIS Board meeting is August 26<sup>th</sup> @ 9:30 AM (conference call). Reasonable to have this information by then?
